BAPTISM SACRAMENT CHECK LIST

- Introductory phone contact with church office and Fr. Anastasios to set date
- Meeting with Father Anastasios to go over the Sacrament of Baptism
- Stewardship pledge and obligation fulfilled

- Paperwork and application

On the day of the baptism you will need the following items that can be provided by the parents or godparents:

- a large new candle (please do not plan to use candles used in previous Sacrament)
- two small new candles (please do not plan to use candles used in previous Sacrament)
- a small bottle of olive oil, (please understand that the olive oil and its container will not be returned to you. They have been blessed and must remain in the church)
- a bar of soap
- two small white hand towels
- one large white bath towel
- a white sheet (size twin – flat)
- a new white outfit for the baby including undershirt, hat, socks (or tights) and shoes
- a Cross with a chain to be worn by the child
