**The reading is from Apostle Paul's
Letter to the Hebrews 4:14-16, 5:1-6**

BRETHREN, since we have a high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we have not a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. For every high priest chosen from among men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He can deal gently with the ignorant and wayward, since he himself is beset with weakness. Because of this he is bound to offer sacrifice for his own sins as well as for those of the people. And one does not take the honor upon himself, but he is called by God, just as Aaron was. So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, "Thou art my Son, today I have begotten thee"; as he says also in another place, "Thou art a priest for ever, after the order of Melchizedek."

Archiepiscopal Encyclical on Greek Independence Day

March 25, 2025

Unto the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, the Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, the Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, the Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and the entirety of the Christ-named Plenitude of the Holy Archdiocese of America:

**The New Creation revealed the Creator by showing Himself to us whom He created
(Akathist Hymn, Third Stasis, N)**

Beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The “New Creation” that we celebrate every March 25th is both a spiritual and a political reality for Orthodox Christians of Greek descent, for Philhellenes around the world, and indeed for every human being. What occurred within the Ever-Virgin’s womb is nothing less than the re-creation of the human race and, through us as God’s chosen stewards, the entirety of the created cosmos. And what occurred in 1821 within the hearts and minds of Greek patriots, is nothing less than the re-creation of a Nation, to which we – as stewards – owe a debt of responsibility and fidelity.


The Annunciation of the Theotokos was perfected by the exercise of her freedom on behalf of every man, woman, and child who would ever live. And the Revolution of 1821, an astonishing exercise of liberty, led to the independence and ultimate rebirth of Hellas. The former was a Divine Act enabled by a human being; the latter, a human endeavor empowered

by a Divine Hand. In both, there was the grace of a Virgin Full-of-Grace, a young girl who incarnated the best of our aspirations to freedom, and was the Vessel of the Incarnation of God.

Let us never forget our Virgin Champion who manifests what it means to be truly free in God. And let us never forget the Immortal Heroes of 1821, whose sacrifices showed the world what it means to fight and overcome tyranny, and to protect, defend, and prosper the People of Greece. Let us always choose to be that New Creation in Christ.

Long live 1821! Long live Democracy! Long live Greece!

Προσφιλείς ἀδελφοί και ἀδελφές ἐν Χριστῷ,

Ἡ «καινή κτίσις» ποῦ εορτάζουμε κάθε 25^η Μαρτίου εἶναι ταυτοχρόνως και πνευματική και πολιτική πραγματικότητα για τούς ὀρθοδόξους χριστιανούς ἑλληνικής καταγωγῆς, ἀλλά και για τούς ἀνά τόν κόσμο φιλέλληνες, και για κάθε ἄνθρωπο. Ὅτι συνέβη στή μήτρα της ἀειπαρθένου δέν εἶναι τίποτε λιγότερο ἀπό τήν ἀναδημιουργία τοῦ ἀνθρωπίνου γένους και, μέσω ἡμῶν τῶν χριστιανῶν ὡς οἰκονόμων τοῦ Θεοῦ, ὀλοκλήρου τοῦ κόσμου. Ὅτι συνέβη τό 1821 μέ τή γενναιότητα και τήν αὐτοθυσία τῶν ἑλλήνων πατριωτῶν δέν εἶναι τίποτε ἄλλο παρὰ ἡ ἀναγέννηση τοῦ ἔθνους μας, πρὸς τό ὅποιο ἔχουμε χρέος εὐθύνης για τή συνέχειά του.

Ὁ Εὐαγγελισμός της Θεοτόκου ἐπιτελέσθηκε μέ τήν ἐλεύθερη βούληση και συγκατάθεση της Παναγίας μας, ἡ ὅποια ἐκπροσωπεῖ κάθε ἄνδρα, γυναίκα και παιδί ἀπό τήν ἀρχή ἕως της συντελείας τοῦ κόσμου. Και ἡ ἐπανάσταση τοῦ 1821 ἀποτέλεσε μία

συγκλονιστική πράξη ἐλευθερίας, καθὼς ὀδήγησε στὴν ἀνεξαρτησία καὶ τὴν ἀναγέννηση τῆς πατρίδας μας Ἑλλάδας. Ἡ πρώτη πράξη ἦταν θεία βούληση, ποὺ ἐπιτεύχθηκε μὲ τὴ συνεργασία τοῦ ἀνθρώπου· ἡ δευτέρη πράξη ἦταν ἀνθρώπινη προσπάθεια, ποὺ ἐνισχύθηκε ἀπὸ τὸ χέρι τοῦ Θεοῦ. Καὶ στὶς δύο περιπτώσεις, τὸ πρόσωπο τῆς ἀειπαρθένου κεχαριτωμένης νεαρῆς Παναγίας μας ἦταν παρὼν ὡς τὸ κατ' ἔξοχὴν σκεῦος ἐκλογῆς τοῦ Θεοῦ, ἐνσαρκώνοντας τὰ ὑψηλότερα ὄνειρά μας γιὰ ἐλευθερία.

Ἄς μὴ ξεχνοῦμε ποτὲ τὴν ἀειπάρθενο προστάτιδά μας, ἡ ὁποία μᾶς δείχνει τι σημαίνει νὰ εἶναι κανεὶς πραγματικὰ ἐλεύθερος μὲ τὸ Θεό. Καὶ ἄς μὴ ξεχάσουμε ποτὲ τοὺς ἀθάνατους ἥρωες τοῦ 1821, ποὺ μὲ τὶς θυσίες τους ἔδειξαν στὸν κόσμον τὸ τί σημαίνει νὰ πολεμᾶς καὶ νὰ νικᾶς τὴν τυραννία, νὰ προστατεύεις, νὰ υπερασπιζεσαι καὶ νὰ ὀδηγεῖς στὴν πρόοδο τὸν ἑλληνικὸ λαό. Ἄς ἔχουμε λοιπὸν κι ἐμεῖς ὡς στόχο νὰ γίνουμε «καινὴ κτίσις ἐν Χριστῷ».

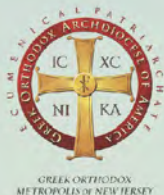

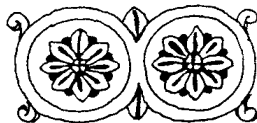
